The Conrad Weiser Area School District is proud to announce that ten (10) of its students have received recognitions from the College Board for their exceptional achievement on the college-level Advanced Placement (AP) exams.

Selected as *scholar* were Jonathan Clark, Christopher Manley and Heather Pray. These students scored the grade 3 or better on at least three (3) AP exams.

Five students received the recognition of *scholar* with honors. Amanda Binkley, Lauren Boyer, Kelly Paul, Sarah Peterson and Luke Sutliff earned an average on 3.25 on at least four exams.

Raymond Edwards Jr. and Alex Youst were named *scholar* with Distinction. These students achieved an average on 3.5 or better on five or more exams.

Most of the nation's colleges and universities award credit, advanced placement or both based on successful performance on the AP exams. Fewer than 18% of the more than 1.4 million students nation wide challenged that exams received this recognition.
