Athletic Hall of Fame Inductees Honored

AMBER DAWSON

-Amber competed in archery competitions nationally and internationally while she was at CW, Texas A & M and beyond

-at the Junior Level, Amber held three individual indoor world records and one outdoor record for at least four years and won an individual gold medal in 2000 and a team gold in 2001 at the Jr. World Championship

-Amber was a member of the US Archery Team from 2000 to 2005, which won team gold in five international championships, individual silver medal twice and placed 5th and 7th individually; her teams set world records in two of those competitions

-attended Texas A&M on an archery scholarship; Texas A&M won the overall national title all three years she competed

-In 2002 she placed 2nd, in 2003 she placed 5th and in 2004 she placed 2nd individually in the US Intercollegiate Archery Championships
