You have *violated* the dress code if:

- You are wearing attire that has messages or pictures with reference to the Confederate flag, drugs, alcohol, suicide, sexual innuendoes, ethnic references, profanity, violence, or weapons.
- You are wearing clothing with holes or tears in inappropriate places.
- You are wearing halter-tops, tube tops, spaghetti straps, tank tops, racerback tops or showing your midriff.
- You are wearing shorts or pants with exposed pockets.
- Your back, cleavage and shoulders are *not* covered.
- Your undergarments are visible.
- No blankets will be allowed to be used during the course of the day.
- Your shorts or skirts are not an appropriate length as determined by the CWHS staff's discretion.
- You are wearing a hat or a hood or if your head is covered for reasons other than religious or medical purposes.
- You are wearing a coat that extends below your knees.
- You are wearing a coat that is intended for outdoor wear (as determined by the CWHS staff's discretion).

Student Parking: Students who drive to school will be allowed to park in the student parking lot. This is the lot that has the numbered spaces in front of the auditorium. Students should not park in any of the spaces that are marked with a red line in the student lot, these are for teachers and staff. There will not be any reserved spots, permit tags, or charge to park this year. Students may also park in the middle school parking lot. This is the lot between the middle school and high school.

The annual **Blue/White Night** will be held Thursday, August 26 at 6:30pm. All Conrad Weiser staff & students are encouraged to come out to the stadium and meet this fall's athletic teams. Admission is free & the concession stand will be open. CW's Marching Band will perform an excerpt from their half-time routine and all high school fall athletes will be introduced. Athletes are reminded to report to the stadium (concession stand area) no later than 6:15pm.

Picture Day will be on Sept. 9. All students must have their picture taken so that they receive a valid student ID. Picture order envelopes were mailed home this summer. If you need an extra order envelope, they are in the HS

office. Parents can order online before picture day at mylifetouch.com. Online orders will only be accepted up to 48 hours after Picture Day.
