Location and Communities Served

The Conrad Weiser Area School District is located in the southwestern corner of Berks County. It serves the communities of Marion Township, Heidelberg Township, North Heidelberg Township, South Heidelberg Township, the boroughs of Wernersville, Robesonia, and Womelsdorf, and the villages of Stouchsburg and Fritztown.

School

Conrad Weiser is a high school with an enrollment of 913 in grades 9-12. The school operates on a 4x4 semester block schedule.

AP Courses and Scores

Conrad Weiser offers 15 Advanced Placement courses in various academic disciplines. Students who take an AP course are required to take the exam. Students also take AP exams in other areas.

Curriculum/Schedule

Conrad Weiser High School offers a varied curriculum but requires all students to pass 4 credits in English, 4 credits in social studies, 3 in math, 3 in science and a fourth credit in math or science. Students must earn a total of 27 credits. In most major subject areas, students can take courses at the honors level, college prep level, or a regular level.

Community Service

All students must complete twenty hours of community service to graduate. Students may volunteer at a wide variety of community organizations beginning in the summer following their eighth grade year. Student transcripts show the number of hours the student has documented.

All graded courses are included in the determination of class rank. Class rank is determined by the weighted grade point average. Beginning with grade 9, the rank average is cumulative and is calculated at the end of the freshman, sophomore, junior, and senior years.

Physical Education and Service Learning are graded on a Pass/Fail basis; it is also possible to receive a grade of "O" for Outstanding in Physical Education. A grade of "F" affects class rank, but "O" or "P" does not.

Graduation Project

Students will focus on career planning and professional preparation by completing Career Cruising activities, job shadowing experiences, and the development of a professional cover letter and resume. A portfolio will be created to show the aforementioned career preparation.

Students will be scheduled for an exit interview conducted by teachers and staff who will ask questions about the career exploration journey in addition to questions about their Conrad Weiser experience.
