LOCAL SCHOLARSHIPS SPECIFICALLY FOR GRADUATING SENIORS OF CONRAD WEISER HIGH SCHOOL

CONRAD WEISER RENAISSANCE SCHOLARSHIP

If you had a Renaissance card every year 9th grade-12th grade, you are eligible to apply for the Renaissance Scholarship. Stop by the Library for the application. All applications are due back by April 18th

DONALD ZERBE SCHOLARSHIP – WOMELSDORF ROD AND GUN CLUB

A minimum of three \$1,000 scholarships are available to CW seniors who plan to further their education at an accredited college or university. Applicants do not have to live in Womelsdorf to be eligible. College acceptance letter and essay required. Application deadline is April 24th.

HEATH HASSLER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

In memory of a 2004 Conrad Weiser graduate, this scholarship opportunity is available to students who have overcome or are presently dealing with a medical challenge or hardship. Application deadline is April 12th.

SCOUTS BASEBALL ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP IN MEMORY OF TERRY W. REBER

The CW Baseball Alumni Association is pleased to award this scholarship to a senior player on the baseball team who represents the CW community positively by exhibiting good character and leadership abilities and has been accepted at a college or university for the Fall 2019 semester. Applications can be obtained from Coach Billingsley. Deadline to submit applications is April 30th.

TERRY REBER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP-EDUCATION MAJOR

Conrad Weiser seniors are eligible to receive a scholarship in memory of former CW Superintendent, Mr. Terry W. Reber. This scholarship will be awarded to a senior who will be attending college in the fall to major in Education. Applicants must have participated in CW athletics as an athlete or as a manager, and have a GPA of 3.0 or better. Essay required. Application deadline is May 11th.

TERRY REBER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP-COLLEGIATE ATHLETE

In memory of Mr. Reber, a former CW teacher, coach & administrator, this scholarship will be awarded to a senior who is planning to continue playing sports at the collegiate level. Applicants must have participated in CW athletics as an athlete or manager, and have a GPA of 3.0, and be enrolled in an accredited School, College or University. Application deadline is May 11th.

WERNERSVILLE FAIR COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

If you have demonstrated a strong commitment to the community through your volunteer efforts, you are eligible to apply for one of two \$500 awards. This opportunity is available to all graduating seniors whether your plans are to further your education at a 2 or 4-year college or technical school, enter the workforce or join a branch of the US Military. Application deadline is May 11th.

WOMAN'S CLUB OF WERNERSVILLE

The Woman's Club of Wernersville will be awarding a \$500 scholarship to a Conrad Weiser senior who will continue his/her education at a two or four-year college or university or technical school. The student must be in the top third of the senior class but not one of the top ten individuals. Essay required. Additional information and applications are available in the Counseling Office. Deadline to apply is April 12th.

GENERAL SCHOLARSHIPS

2019 BERKS AREA SCHOOL COUNSELOR ASSOCIATION

This new scholarship is available to students who have shown improvement academically, socially, or behaviorally throughout their educational time. Applicants can be continuing post-secondary education and/or pursuing employment and use the scholarship for expenses. Applications are available in the Counseling Office with a deadline of April 5, 2019.

BERKS COUNTY MEDICAL SOCIETY ALLIANCE, INC.

Graduating seniors who are residents of Berks County and are preparing to enter the Medical or Allied Health Field and planning to attend a training program or college located in Berks County are eligible to apply for this scholarship opportunity. Award recipients will be based on financial need and academic capability. Deadline to apply is April 19, 2019.

BERKS COUNTY MUSHROOM GROWERS

Two, \$1000 scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors who are planning to further their education in the fields of Agriculture, Home Economics, Science or Food Service. Essay required. Application deadline is May 1, 2019.

2019 FOUNDATION IN CHEMISTRY AWARD

The Lehigh Valley Section of the American Chemical Society is offering this \$1,000 award to a senior who will be majoring in chemistry, biochemistry, or chemical engineering attending a college or university in the Lehigh Valley Section. To be eligible, a student must have completed one year of college preparatory chemistry, four years of mathematics, and one semester of college preparatory physics. By high school graduation. Deadline to apply is April 24th.

HORATIO ALGER ASSOCIATION

This association is inviting students interested in enrolling in Career and Technical Education programs for Fall 2019 to apply for this scholarship. Up to 1020 scholarships will be awarded in 2019 with a maximum amount of \$2,500 depending on the length and cost of the program. Scholarship criteria includes: high school completion by the spring of 2019, commitment to pursue & complete a career or technical certificate/degree and US citizenship. Applications are being accepted online beginning March 15 at application.horatioalger.org with a first priority deadline of June 15, 2019.

JOHN G. BERNHEISER EDUCATIONAL AWARD

In tribute to John's memory, Riverfront Credit Union is selecting five students to receive a grant of \$2,000 toward an undergraduate study program at a qualifying institution. To be eligible for this award you must have an active savings account, if not you may open one by May 31, 2019. A cumulative GPA of at least 3.0, a "B" or 80% is also required. Application deadline is June 5, 2019.

2019 PAT GANTER

This \$1,000 scholarship is available to a Berks County High School senior who is active in substance abuse prevention in their school or community. Students must be planning to pursue an education in one of the following areas: human services, behavioral health, social work, addictions studies, criminal justice, or psychology. Essay required. Deadline is April 12, 2019.

READING HOT STOVERS

The Reading Hot Stovers will be awarding college scholarships to high school seniors who have been accepted into a 4-year accredited college/university, have played at least two years of baseball or softball at the high school level and be in the top 50% of the graduating class with at least a 2.5 GPA. Applications are available from your coaches and also the Counseling Office, with a deadline to return completed materials by June 6, 2019.

STEVEN E. SCOTT SCHOLARSHIP FUND

This award has been established by the Commonwealth Fire Protection Company to honor the past president & founding owner. One \$7500, two \$5000 and one \$2500 scholarships will be given to students planning on furthering their education in a Construction Trade related to curriculum. The criteria includes: The student is attending an accredited college/university, a community college, or trade/technical school in a 50-mile radius of Leola PA or a 25-mile radius of Wilmington, DE & a 2.50 GPA in their most recent academic year. Application deadline is May 8, 2019.

FINANCIAL AID TIPS OF THE MONTH

CONRAD WEISER STUDENT LOAN

Conrad Weiser seniors who plan to continue education after graduation are eligible to apply for this student loan opportunity. Loan amounts vary each year ranging from \$1500 to \$2500. This loan is not based on financial need and is renewable for all four years of your undergraduate education. No interest is calculated while you are enrolled full-time and for an additional 1-year period thereafter. The CW Student Loan is funded by private donations. No tax money is used for this loan opportunity. Applications are available from the Career Resource Center and must be submitted to Mrs. Beth Shartle in Central Administration by June 15, 2019. **A letter detailing loan amounts and disbursement will be mailed to the applicants after July 1, 2019.**
