HORATIO ALGER ASSOCIATION

If integrity, determination and courage describe you—then, you have what it takes to be a Horatio Alger Scholar. The Horatio Alger Association rewards students who possess the character to succeed in life. These awards, ranging in value from \$6,000 to \$25,000 help students overcome the financial barriers of pursuing higher education. You must have at least a 2.0 GPA and require financial assistance to go to college. An online application at scholars.horatioalger.org must be submitted, along with all other required documentation, by October 25, 2018.

Seniors who have made a difference by serving the community and distinguishing themselves through volunteer work will be considered for this \$1,000 scholarship opportunity.
