FEBRUARY/MARCH

APRIL/MAY

What colleges do you want to visit? Make a list...call or email admissions offices for appointments or **Open House** dates. Become familiar with the college websites....a wealth of information.

Check out which local organizations offer **scholarships** for graduating seniors...make a list of scholarships that you want to apply for. Get your community service hours completed and turned in to the Counseling Office.

JUNE/JULY/AUGUST

Visit the schools that you are interested in...make sure that you pick up application materials. Ask the admissions counselor if the college offers fee waivers to students who visit their campus.

Take careful notes on each school (use the *Campus Visit Score Card* from College Board)...do you feel good on campus...do you feel like you were treated well...do they have everything you are looking for???. Remember college selection is a romance and not a race..

Write a follow up note or email to the admissions counselor who took the time to give you a tour.

Begin reviewing information for your **Career Project**...Look for information on Schoology.

Start your file for information that you will need for completing applications...we want your college **applications into Counseling by Thanksgiving**. That will be here before you know it!
