Mitigation update:

On behalf of the Conrad Weiser Area School District Administration and the Pandemic Recovery Team, this message serves as an organizational update regarding the latest information from the Governors' Office and Pennsylvania Department of Health (DOH).

On May 4, 2021, the Wolf Administration, in coordination with the COVID-19 Vaccine Joint Task Force, announced that the Secretary of Health's and Governor's Orders on [targeted mitigation](#) and the [public school attestation](#) will be lifted on May 31, 2021 (<https://www.media.pa.gov/pages/health-details.aspx?newsid=1437>). The current order requiring Pennsylvanians to wear masks will remain until the benchmark of 70% of Pennsylvanians age 18 and older being fully vaccinated is reached.

We will continue to monitor local community data and information from the Governor's Office, DOH, and PDE. An overview will be shared with the Conrad Weiser Area School District Board of Directors and updates will be communicated to staff members as needed.

The health and safety of students, families, and staff remain a top priority. The Conrad Weiser Area School District will carefully review the information to determine how the lifting of several mitigation orders may impact any end-of-year events planned for June 1 through the end of the school year.

As we approach June 1, 2021, please continue to adhere to all current health and safety protocols in place to mitigate the transmission of the virus by wearing face coverings, practicing recommended hand hygiene, maintaining physical distance when outside the home, conducting daily health self-screenings, and remaining home if ill.
