Survey Response Details

- ▶ Total Respondents: 1,901
 - ▶ Students: 287
 - ▶ Employees: 325
 - ▶ Parents/Guardians: 1,273

I AGREE OR STRONGLY AGREE...

...that I want school to open for in-person instruction in the Fall.

...that a face covering should be worn when social distancing is not possible.

I AGREE OR STRONGLY AGREE...

...that students should wear a face covering while riding the school bus.

...that CWASD promotes the health, safety, and welfare of students and the community

Student-Specific Questions

- ▶ 60% of students are not worried about getting sick if they return
- ▶ 83% of students missed their teachers during the shutdown
- ▶ 92% of students missed their friends during the shutdown
- ▶ 71% of students reported that it was harder for them to learn at home than at school

Parent/Guardian-Specific Questions

- ▶ 65% of parents whose child(ren) rides a bus to school plan to send them on the bus
- ▶ 53% of parents are comfortable if face coverings are not required in classrooms
- ▶ 93% of parents report that there is a reliable Internet connection at home and available for their child(ren)
- ▶ 54% of parents reported that their child(ren) did not learn well during the shutdown
- ▶ Top 3 greatest challenges March – June:
 - ▶ #1: Separation from classmates: 71%
 - ▶ #2: Separation from teachers: 68%
 - ▶ #3: Availability of printed materials: 24%
- ▶ 71% of parents reported being somewhat or very comfortable with the start of school being August 24, 2020

Employee-Specific Questions

- ▶ 35% of employees are comfortable if face covering are not required
- ▶ 73% of employees believe that all staff should have their temperatures taken at the start of each work day
- ▶ 56% of employees are generally worried about returning to work in the Fall
- ▶ 21% of employees believe that children can learn just as well remotely as they can in the classroom
- ▶ 65% of employees reported being somewhat or very comfortable with the start of school being August 24, 2020
